About the GA Program:

- GAs work with the Head of College, college staff, the head GA for each college, and undergraduate students to organize social and educational events. You can find more information about a college's specific GA program by looking at the college website.
- These GA positions are non-residential and do not allow graduate or professional students to live in the colleges. Applicants must live in the New Haven area.
- GAs receive special access to their college, two dining halls meals per week, and the opportunity to be involved in activities ranging from college-wide educational, cultural and social events to photography, pottery, art and drama, poetry readings, music, language tables, science groups, research events, and career advising.
- Eligibility All degree-seeking Yale graduate and professional students are eligible to apply. Colleges generally appoint GAs from a range of backgrounds, schools, and fields of study. You do <u>not</u> need to be an alumnus/a of Yale College to apply to participate in the GA program. Current GAs do not need to reapply.
